The animals' good intentions are rewarded when the farmers' grandchildren proclaim the evening "the best Christmas ever!" Rewritten verses from Clement Moore's classic poem are interspersed with the sometimes silly but always pleasing story. Cazet's ink drawings, brightened with colorful washes, create strongly narrative and frequently comical scenes. The pictures of chickens with plastic forks tied to their heads as antlers are worth the price of the book all by themselves.
